By God's grace, I will commit to serve our church, the body of Christ, in the following way s :

Ministry of Worship & Music

- Usher:** Serve on the usher rotation for Lord's Day Services
- Servant on Sundays:** Assist with the opening and closing of the buildings on Sunday.
- Audio/Visual Volunteer:** Become trained and available to assist with use of church's audio equipment during worship services and other activities.
- Assist with set up for Worship:** Assist with setting up communion-filling trays and cups and refilling between morning services, assisting with special services, etc.
- Prayer Chair:** Following a provided guide, members pray for the morning worship services as they are in process.
- Wedding Coordinator:** Become trained and available to assist with weddings.
- Chancel Choir Member:** Folks of all ages and skill levels can assist in worship leadership by using their gifts and talents to praise our Lord through singing.
- Handbell Choir:** Join others interested in improving their ability to read music and lead in worship. This is a great initial exposure to instrumental music.
- Children's Choir Helper:** Assist choir director with weekly choir rehearsals. No musical experience required.
- Other Instrumentalists:** Those able to play guitar, flute, etc. are encouraged to seek ways of using their gifts through the music ministry.

Ministry to Children

(Young Children: Birth-Kindergarten)

- Teach Sunday School:** Teach one of our preschool Sunday School classes.
- Help in Sunday School:** Be a helper for a teacher in one of the young children's Sunday School classes.
- Substitute Teach Sunday School:** Be available to substitute teach for a teacher due to illness, vacation, etc.
- Teach 3-Year-Olds on Wednesday Nights:** Teach the 3-year-olds during our Wednesday night program.
- Teach Preschoolers Summer Sunday Nights:** Work with our preschool children on Sunday nights during the summer.
- Teach Preschool Pioneer Clubs:** Work with our preschoolers in the Pioneer Club on Sunday nights during the school year.
- Serve in Children's Church:** Work with children ages 4-5 in Children's Church during the 8:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. services once a month.
- Teach Vacation Bible School:** Teach a preschool class during Vacation Bible School.
- Vacation Bible School-Crafts, Music, Snack, Recreation:** Work on the crafts for Vacation Bible School, lead the music during the assembly time or in class, make snacks for the teachers or children, help with recreation.
- Play Piano in Sunday School:** Play the piano for one of our preschool Sunday School classes.

(Older Children: Grades 1-6)

- Teach Sunday School:** Teach one of our older children Sunday School classes.
- Substitute Teach Sunday School:** Be available to substitute teach for a teacher due to sickness, vacation, etc.

Ministry to Children (continued)

(Older Children: Grades 1-6)

- Lead a Pioneer Club:** Work with 5th and 6th grade students in a Pioneer Club on Sunday nights during the school year.
- Teach Catechism Class:** Teach one of our 1st-4th grade catechism classes on Sunday nights during the school year.
- Teach Vacation Bible School:** Teach or co-teach a 1st-6th grade class for Vacation Bible School.
- Vacation Bible School-Crafts, Music, Snack, Recreation:** Work on the crafts for Vacation Bible School, lead the music during the assembly time or in class, make snacks for the teachers or children, help with recreation.
- Teach Summer Sunday Nights:** Work with older children on Sunday nights during the summer.
- Play Piano in Sunday School:** Play the piano for one of our 1st-6th grade Sunday School classes.
- Special Events:** Assist with children's activities for Fall Bible Conference, Missions Conference, chaperone a trip to Surfside Water Park or Alabama Adventure.

Ministry to Youth

- Provide Dinner for Senior High Sunday Night Fellowship**
- Provide Your Home for Youth Fellowships on Sunday Evenings:** Provide a place in your home for the Senior High students to come and have discussion and dinner following the Lord's Day evening service.
- Teach/Team Teach Sunday School:** Teach or team-teach a Sunday School class either in the Junior High or Senior High department.
- Prayer Partnership:** Committing to pray regularly for Youth. Prayer requests to be provided by the Youth Ministry.
- Small Group Discipleship Leader:** Lead a small group of young people, divided by age and gender, for one year in discipleship studies.
- Provide Snacks-Help with Food:** Prepare nutritious food for our young people when they have fellowship and other activities.
- Chaperone Youth Events and Activities:** Be available for transportation and chaperoning duties for a variety of activities both in the Montgomery area and out of town.
- One-on-One Time with Students:** Be available to plan and carry out some one-on-one time with an individual student as needed, such as breakfast, lunch, etc.
- General Help:** Be available to do "whatever is needed" for our Youth and Youth Staff.

Ministry to Singles

- Teach Sunday School:** Be a member of the teaching team for the Singles Sunday School Class.
- Teach Bible Study:** Be a member of the teaching team for the Monday night Singles Bible Study.
- Teach small discipleship groups:** Teach and disciple members of the Singles ministry.
- Service Projects:** Serve on the Singles service project Team.
- Provide Home for Sunday Lunch:** Open your home for the monthly Singles lunch.
- Provide Home for Retreats**
- Provide Food:** Provide food for various Singles events.

Ministry to Adults

- Sunday School Teacher:** If you are gifted with teaching, we can use you.
- Substitute Teach Sunday School:** We always need people to "fill in the gaps".

Ministry to Adults (continued)

- Special Events Volunteer:** Social events need planners and coordinators. We can use your help.
- 3M Volunteer:** Help organize fellowship activities, ministry opportunities, meals, and trips for our more mature members.

Women in the Church (WIC)

Helping Hands Ministry:

- Cook casseroles for families in need
- Deliver casseroles to families in need

Condolence Ministry:

- Cook food for a meal on the day of a funeral
- Serve a meal on the day of a funeral

Lydia Ministry:

- Regularly visit homebound members
- Regularly send cards to homebound members

Prayer Chain:

- Be part of a telephone or e-mail prayer team

College Students Ministry:

- Contact and encourage college students

Special Events:

- Host a WIC General Meeting in your home
- Provide refreshments for a WIC General Meeting
- Provide refreshments for annual John Knox Christmas Party
- Help with the Mother-Daughter Banquet

New Members:

- Welcome and assimilate ladies into the WIC

The Love of Christ Ministry (TLC Ministry):

- Encourage members needing extra TLC

Missions Clothes Closet:

- Sort and mark donated clothes

Small Groups:

- Lead a Small Group
- Participate in a Small Group

Publicity:

- Help with bulletin boards

WIC Council:

- Serve on the Women in the Church council

Flower Ministry:

- Arrange flowers on Monday mornings for homebound or hospitalized members
- Deliver flowers on Monday to homebound or hospitalized members

Ministry of Outreach

- Doorstep Visitation:** Serve on the visitation team that delivers welcome packets to first time Trinity visitors.
- Sunday School Greeter:** Greet people as they enter church for Sunday School and show them to their classroom if needed.
- Follow up with Repeat Visitors:** Help newcomers become assimilated into Trinity.
- Assist with New Members Luncheon:** Volunteer to help with the quarterly luncheon.
- Evangelism:** Be trained to share the gospel with visitors and others in the community.
- Maintain New Member Picture Board:** Compile information on new members and put this and their pictures in the frames when needed.
- Take Photographs of New Members:** This involves calling the new members and setting up a time to take a picture of their family, probably on Sunday at Trinity.

Ministry of Missions

- Community Ministries Committee:** This committee is the focal point for identifying needs in the community and guiding Trinity's efforts to develop holistic spiritual, physical and financial solutions to meet those needs.

Ministry of Missions (continued)

Mt. Meigs Youth Detention Facility: Visit young men incarcerated in this facility, and lead a Bible study discipleship group. Or bake cakes, and assist with the monthly Sunday afternoon birthday celebrations.

Paterson Court Summer Enrichment Ministry: Adults and teenagers are needed to help with weekly enrichment activities including visits to the Fine Arts Museum, zoo, planetarium, ice skating, and creative crafts. Snacks are also needed during the 5-Day Club Vacation Bible School week.

Paterson Court Tutoring: Tutors are needed for elementary children on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday afternoons from 3:00 to 4:30 P.M.

Campus Outreach: Support the Campus Outreach staff at Alabama State and Huntington by inviting college students for dinner or providing snacks for on campus meetings.

Friendship Mission: Bible study leaders and counselors are needed for homeless men and women. There are on-going needs for donated items including bedding, personal hygiene supplies, and financial support.

Let God Arise: Volunteers are needed who will visit jails, witness to and encourage inmates and lead Bible studies.

SAV-A-LIFE: Volunteer counselors, receptionists, administrative assistants, and maintenance workers are needed to support this ministry.

W.L.B.F. Radio Station: Volunteers are needed to assist in coordinating public events and participate in the station's Advisory Board.

Fellowship of Christian Athletes: \$100 will sponsor a huddle discipleship group at senior and junior high schools.

Child Evangelism Fellowship: High school and college students are needed for summer interns who will teach weekly 5-Day Clubs. Adults are

needed who will sponsor a 5-Day Club in their home for neighborhood children.

Young Life: Sponsor a school or neighborhood discipleship group with snacks and study materials. Participate in a volunteer group leader training class and then assist with a suburban or urban group.

S.T.E.P. Foundation: Volunteers are needed to mentor adults in need of job skills and a job. Violence prevention counselors are needed to work with children at public schools.

We Mentor and Big Brother/Big Sister: Mentor an at-risk child in the Weed and Seed neighborhood. The WE Mentor program uses individual and group settings to build relationships with children while the Big Brother/Big Sister program uses individual contact opportunities. Mentor training is provided by both organizations.

Serve on the Missions Committee: Meet with this ministry team monthly to plan and oversee World Missions Ministry.

Attend Tuesday A.M. Prayer Breakfast: Join other members to pray for our missionaries and their ministries weekly.

Participate in Missions Trips: Take a short-term missions trip with other Trinity members.

"Adopt" a Missionary: Write letters of encouragement and pray for a specific missionary.

Assist in Missions Conference: Help with all the little details during the Missions Conference.

House a Missionary: Invite a missionary to stay in your home during the Missions Conference or any other time.

Feed a Missionary: Invite a missionary to your home for a meal during the Missions Conference or any other time.

Go on the Mission Field: If you are interested in serving as a full time missionary, please indicate.

Common Ground Montgomery: Adults are needed to tutor high school students who are a part of this ministry.

Montgomery Christian School (kindergarten): Volunteers are needed to assist with special classroom events and field trips.

Miscellaneous

Church Receptionist Substitute: Act as a receptionist and answer the phone as needed.

Driver: Pick up members and visitors for services using the church vans.
