

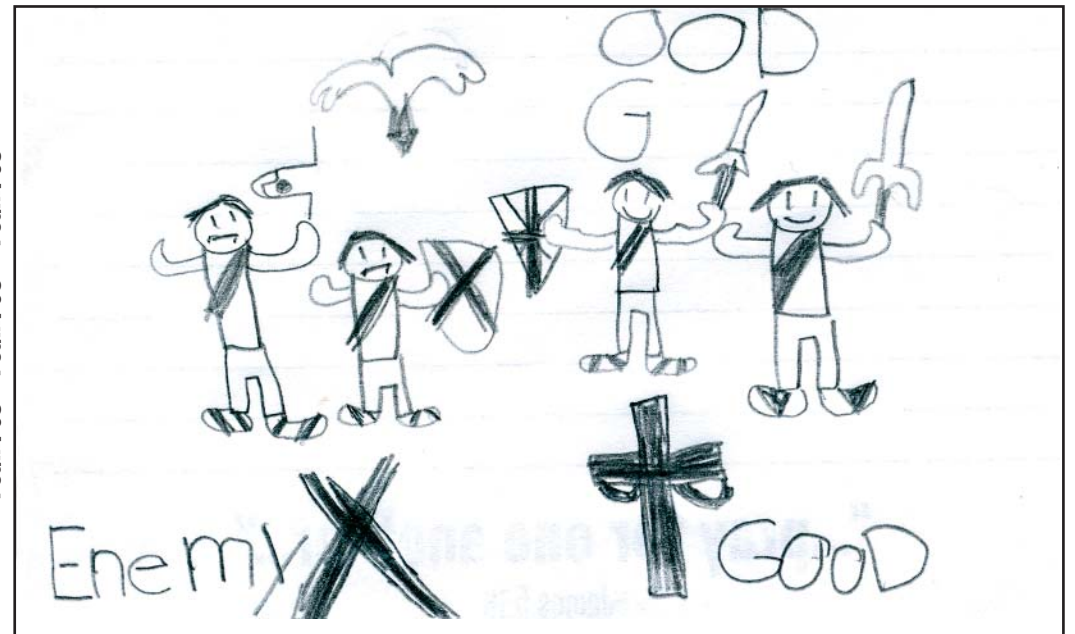

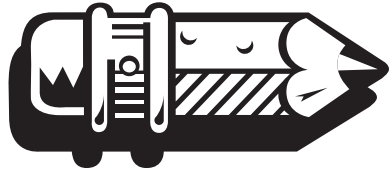

# MUSIC and HYMNS

“Come, Thou Almighty King”

The first verse of this very old hymn (1757) is a plea for God to come into our lives and help us to sing our praises to Him and to reign over us as a King would do. The second one is a plea for God to bless His people and make His Word to have success in every heart and life. Notice the names for God in all four verses: “Almighty King”, “Incarnate Word”, “Holy Comforter”, and “One in Three”. This is just one more of our truly great praise hymns.

“Jesus! What a Friend for Sinners!”

Just look at all the things this hymn writer thought about when he considered Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior! In verse 1, “Friend for \_\_\_\_\_” and “lover of my \_\_\_\_\_”. Verse 2, “\_\_\_\_\_ in weakness”. Verse 3 says “help in \_\_\_\_\_” and “comfort when my \_\_\_\_\_ is breaking”. In verse 4 we see “g\_\_\_\_\_ and k\_\_\_\_\_”, “he my \_\_\_\_\_ hears my cry”. Then in the last verse we are reminded “he hath granted me \_\_\_\_\_”. Isn't it a wonderful comfort that He is a Friend who is with us always---- “saving, helping, keeping, loving; He is with me to the end.”

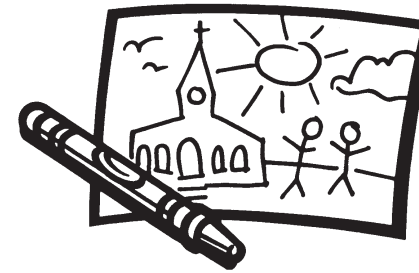
Johan and Lilli have 3 married daughters and five grandchildren.
